

# [Print these Spanish instructions to bring with you](#)

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A taxi from Puerto Plata airports costs about \$35. Public transport will cost about \$5.

If you're choosing public transportation from the airport: you have to schlepp a 1/2 kilometer out to the highway and take a public bus (guagua) or a public car (carro publico) WEST (to the right) for 7 kms to the Gran Parada Junction (shown on illustrated map). This should cost \$1 or \$2 dollars. From there you can wait for another of the above to get to us (spotty service) or if you prefer, hop on a moto-taxi (many available) for the 7.2 km ride up to us, for \$2 or \$3 dollars. You can show your Spanish speaking taxi or moto driver the following instructions as to where you want to go:

"Quiero ir a la casa del canadiense en el Kilometro 19 de la Carretera Turistica, 1 kilometro despues de La "U", donde hay un señor que se llama "POPEA" que vende cocos en la carretera."

Translation: "I want to go to the house of the Canadian guy located at Kilometer 19 of the Tourist Highway, located 1 kilometer after The "U" (a 180-degree switchback curve), where there is a man named Popea who sells coconuts on the side of the road"

When you get here, turn up the dirt road on the right, drive up the little hill and straight to the end (app 200 meters), or if you're walking, follow the stone path that cuts across the field and leads right in....
